
## KS1150 Frameless Finish with Wood Cladding or Boards



Prolonged unprotected exposure to heat may be detrimental to the appearance or long term performance of the wall lining.



## Notes:

- All dimensions are in mm. DO NOT SCALE OFF THESE DRAWINGS
- This detail is to assist in the installation of a **frameless finish** to a Mode KS1150 Gas Fireplace. They offer pathways for protection of heat sensitive linings and finishes.
- Escea recommends when using these finishing methods that a 10mm substrate is used.
- The custom black MS Angle is to protect the hardwood cladding (e.g. Hardwood/Cedar/Fluted Panels) from direct heat from the fire. Prolonged unprotected exposure to heat will affect the cladding.
- Black fireplace reveals must be able to be removed ensure any adhesive or compound is kept clear.
